Shall the Board of Directors of the Calamus-Wheatland Community School District in the Counties of Clinton and Scott, State of Iowa, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy annually, as determined by the Board, a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not to exceed sixty-seven cents (67¢) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2021, to be used for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by Iowa law?
